SEED MIX

- 20% Candy Stick Festolium
- 15% Climax Timothy
- 10% Stallion Timothy
- 10% Bestfor Tetraploid Ryegrass
- 10% Smooth Bromegrass
- 10% Kentucky Bluegrass
- 10% Rambler Alfalfa
- 5% Ladino Clover



CANDY STICK FESTULOLIUM

A very palatable grass that is high in energy and nutrient value. Festulolium is a cross between Meadow Fescue and Perennial Ryegrass. This cross captures the high palatability and forage quality identified with perennial ryegrass yet improves winter-hardiness and consistent summer growth of the Meadow Fescue. Candy Stick Festulolium will be the first grass eaten in the food plot and will provide improved digestion, protein and minerals.

CLIMAX TIMOTHY

Climax Timothy is later starting than Stallion but yields best in the spring as well as later in the season.

STALLION TIMOTHY

A high-yielding, early timothy for early spring and late season pasture performance.

BESTFOR TETRAPLOID RYEGRASS

High palatability, fast establishing, high yielding forage grass that allows for earlier use of the pasture.

SMOOTH BROMEGRASS

For mid-season pasture when early grasses have lost their vigor. Excellent persistence.

KENTUCKY BLUEGRASS

Excellent early and late-season pasture, very persistent, high palatability, takes continuous pasturing. Takes the wear of high traffic.

RAMBLER ALFALFA

A creeping alfalfa variety. Legumes provide higher protein and energy. Excellent persistence in midsummer. Creeping alfalfas will persist longer in pastures than tap root varieties.

LADINO CLOVER

The most palatable of the clovers. A high protein food source that is persistent and easy to establish.

RECOMMENDED SEEDING RATE

20 – 25 lbs. per acre for best results.
