

### *AN EXCELLENT FOOD SOURCE FOR RINGNECK PHEASANTS*

Game Bird Feed Mix is formulated to attract, protect and feed all types of game birds but it is especially formulated to attract and sustain pheasants by providing nesting cover and a highly palatable full season source of food. This mixture provides good season long cover and food for the birds, yet allows for easy walking during hunting season.

#### FORMULA

20% German Millet  
20% White Proso Millet  
20% Milo  
20% Spring Wheat  
10% Sorghum Sudan grass  
10% Berseem Clover

#### GERMAN MILLET

German Millet is an excellent source of protein and minerals desired by pheasants and most game birds. It also provides excellent cover very early after planting and holds its seed throughout the winter.

#### WHITE PROSO MILLET

White Proso Millet is an excellent source of protein, energy, and minerals desired by pheasants and most game birds. It provides excellent cover early after planting and holds its seed throughout the winter.

#### MILO

Milo provides excellent source of energy and minerals game birds need for winter survival. They provide excellent cover throughout late summer and fall and help produce runways to protect birds from predators.

#### SPRING WHEAT

Spring Wheat provides a good source of protein and minerals game birds need along with a good source of cover.

#### BERSEEM CLOVER

Berseem Clover is an annual clover that establishes very quickly and provides an excellent source of highly palatable food shortly after planting. It also an excellent source of nitrogen for the following growing season.

#### SORGHUM SUDAN GRASS

Sorghum Sudan grass provide quality cover to protect birds from predators.

#### PLANTING & SEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

This mixture is best planted in 4" rows, around corn planting time for best results.  
Recommended Seeding Rate: Use 40-50 lbs per acre in a well prepared seed bed.

#### FERTILIZATION

**Recommendation:** Apply 300 lbs. High Calcium Lime and 200 lbs 7-8-7 GreenGuard Vegetable & Flower Fertilizer per acre before seeding. This will improve grow bigger birds improve grain quality and yield.
